REPORT OF INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS' ON APPLYING AGREED-UPON PROCEDURES

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by the Democratic Executive Committee, (the Committee), solely to assist the Committee in evaluating its compliance with Ohio Rev. Code Sections 3517.1012, 3517.17, and 3517.18, for the year ended December 31, 2005. The Committee is responsible for complying with these requirements. We followed the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants' attestation standards for agreed-upon procedures engagements. The sufficiency of the procedures is solely the responsibility of the Committee. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

Cash Receipts

1. We inquired of the Committee whether they deposited all gifts from corporations, labor organizations and all gifts restricted to operations into the same fund into which they deposit amounts received from the State Tax Commissioner. The Committee informed us they did not receive any gifts from corporations or labor unions.
2. We footed the *Statement of Political Party Restricted Fund Deposits* Ohio Rev. Code Section 3517.17 requires (Deposit Form 31-CC), filed for 2005.
3. We confirmed amounts received from the State Tax Commissioner pursuant to Ohio Rev. Code 3517.17(A), with the State of Ohio and agreed them to amounts shown on Deposit Form 31-CC filed for 2005. We found no exceptions.

Cash Reconciliation

1. We recomputed the mathematical accuracy of the December 31, 2005 reconciliation for the bank account used for receipts and disbursements restricted pursuant to Ohio Rev. Code Section 3517.1012(A). We found no computational errors.
2. We agreed the bank balance on the reconciliation to the bank statement balance as of December 31, 2005. The balances agreed.
3. We agreed reconciling items appearing on the reconciliation to canceled checks, deposit slips or to other supporting documentation. There were no reconciling items as of December 31, 2005.

Cash Disbursements

1. We footed the *Statement of Political Party Restricted Fund Disbursements* Ohio Rev. Code Section 3517.17 requires (Disbursement Form 31-M), filed for 2005.
2. For one of the disbursements on Disbursement Form 31-M, we traced the payee and amount to the payee invoice and to the payee's name on the canceled check. The other five payments were all made to the United States Postmaster for postage. The payees and amounts recorded on Disbursement Form 31-M agreed to the payees and amounts on the canceled checks.
3. We compared the signature on the 2005 checks to the list of authorized signatories the Committee provided to us. The signatory on all checks we selected was an approved signatory. We compared the endorsement to the payee listed on the check without exception.
4. We compared the purpose of each disbursement listed on Disbursement Form 31-M, filed for 2005, to the purpose listed on the vendor invoice and to the purposes Ohio Rev. Code 3517.18 permits. Only one vendor invoice was presented as support out of a total of six disbursements made. For those disbursements which had no invoice, each was paid to the United States Postmaster for postage. We found no instances where the purpose described on the invoice was inconsistent with the purposes Ohio Rev. Code permits.

Payroll Disbursements

There were no personnel positions paid with Ohio Political Party Fund monies during the year ended December 31, 2005.

We were not engaged to, and did not perform an examination, the objective of which would be to express an opinion on compliance for the *Statement of Political Party Restricted Fund Deposits* filed for 2005. Accordingly, we do not express an opinion. Had we performed additional procedures, other matters might have come to our attention that we would have reported to you.
