We have completed certain procedures in accordance with Ohio Rev. Code Section 117.01(G) to the accounting records and related documents of the Village of Miller City, Putnam County, Ohio (the Village) for the years ended December 31, 2014 and 2013.

Our procedures were designed solely to satisfy the audit requirements of Ohio Rev. Code Section 117.11(A). Because our procedures were not designed to opine on the Village's financial statements, we did not follow *generally accepted auditing standards*. We do not provide any assurance on the Village's financial statements, transactions or balances for the years ended December 31, 2014 and 2013.

The Village's management is responsible for preparing and maintaining its accounting records and related documents. Our responsibility under Ohio Rev. Code Section 117.11(A) is to examine, analyze and inspect these records and documents.

Current Year Observation

Water and sewer collections were posted entirely as intergovernmental revenues when they should have been posted as charges for services during 2014 and 2013.

We recommend that the Fiscal Officer post all transactions in accordance with the guidance established by the Uniform Accounting Network manual. Further, the Village should adopt policies and procedures including a final review of the financial statements by the Fiscal Officer and Council to ensure that errors and omissions are detected and corrected.

Current Status of Matters we Reported in our Prior Engagement

We also reported the matter above in our agreed upon procedures report for 2012 and 2011.
