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INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS' REPORT ON APPLYING AGREED-UPON PROCEDURES

Democratic Executive Committee Madison County 251 Fellows Avenue West Jefferson, Ohio 43162

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by the Madison County Democratic Executive Committee, solely to assist the Committee in evaluating its compliance with Sections 3517.17 and 3517.18 of the Ohio Revised Code for the year ended December 31, 2003. Management is responsible for the Committee's compliance with those requirements. We followed the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants' attestation standards for agreed-upon procedures engagements. The sufficiency of the procedures is solely the responsibility of the Executive Committee. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

Cash Receipts

We confirmed the Ohio Political Party Fund receipts with the State of Ohio and agreed them to amounts shown on the Ohio Campaign Finance Report. An in-kind contribution valued at \$341 was included on the Ohio Campaign Finance Report.

Cash Reconciliation

- We compared the sum of the cash balances recorded on the Committee's Ohio Campaign Finance Report with the cash balances recorded on the bank reconciliation for the Committee as of December 31, 2003. The sums agreed.
- 2. We recomputed the mathematical accuracy of the reconciliation. We found no computational errors.
- 3. We agreed bank balances on the reconciliation with month end bank statements. The balances agreed.
- 4. We agreed reconciling items appearing on that reconciliation to canceled checks and deposit slips. We determined that the dates on those documents support that those items were proper reconciling items at December 31, 2003.

Cash Disbursements

- 1. We footed the cash disbursement listing and compared the listing total to the disbursement total on the Committee's Ohio Campaign Finance Report. The sums agreed.
- 2. The payees and amounts recorded in the cash disbursement journal agreed to the payees and amounts on the canceled checks.
- 3. We compared the signature on the check to the list of authorized signatories the Committee provided to us. We compared the endorsement to the payee listed on the check. We found no discrepancies.

4. We compared the purpose for the disbursement with the allowable uses described in Section 3517.18 of the Ohio Revised Code. We found no exceptions.

We were not engaged to, and did not perform an examination, the objective of which would be the expression of an opinion on compliance of the Ohio Campaign Finance Report which is attached to this report. Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion. Had we performed additional procedures, other matters might have come to our attention that we would have reported to you.
