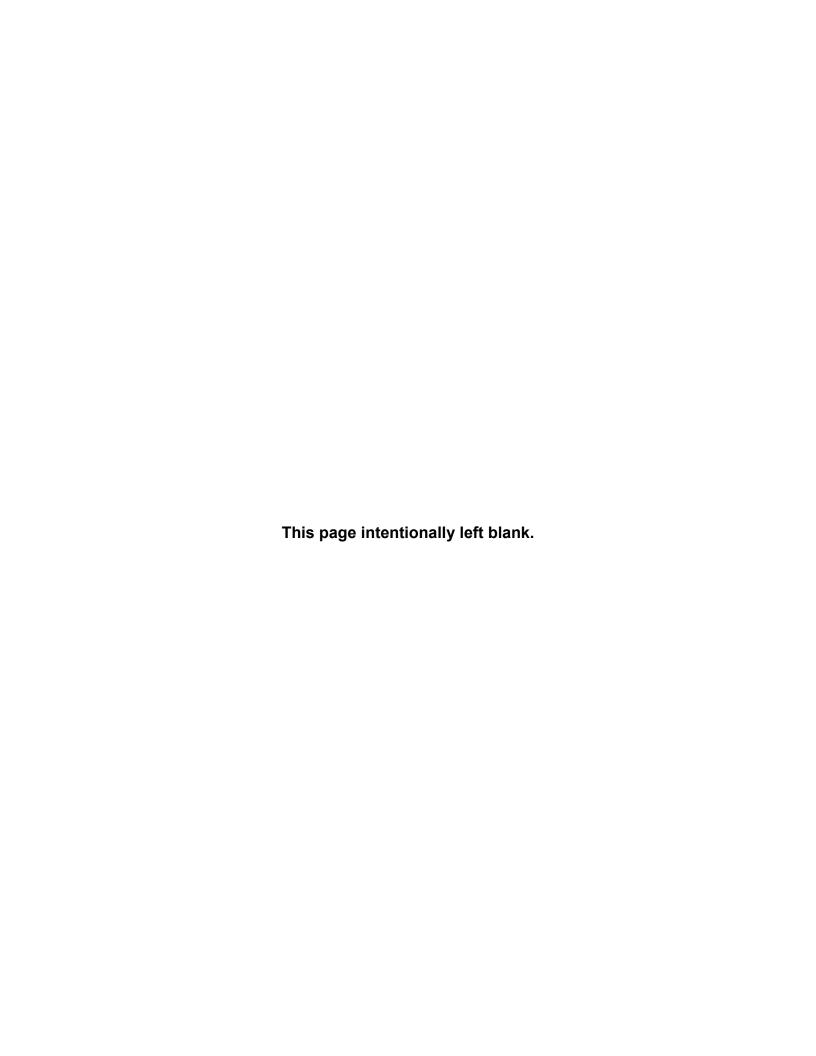

INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS' REPORT ON APPLYING AGREED-UPON PROCEDURES

Democratic Political Party Highland County 5688 State Route 753 Hillsboro, Ohio 45133

To the Executive Committee:

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by the Democratic Executive Committee, Highland County, Ohio (the Executive Committee), solely to assist the Executive Committee in evaluating its compliance with Sections 3517.17 and 3517.18 of the Ohio Revised Code for the year ended December 31, 2003. Management is responsible for the Executive Committee's compliance with those requirements. We followed the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants' attestation standards for agreed-upon procedures engagements. The sufficiency of the procedures is solely the responsibility of the Executive Committee. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

Cash Receipts

We confirmed the Ohio Political Party Fund receipts with the State of Ohio and agreed them to amounts shown on the Political Party Public Funds Report. We found the following exception.

One Auditor of State warrant, distribution transaction list number R20485, dated 10/14/03, in the amount of \$23.06, was not received or deposited by the Democratic Party Treasurer. Per discussion with the Auditor of State's office, this warrant was never cashed or deposited.

This warrant is not recorded in the following fund statement. We recommend that the Executive Committee Treasurer contact the Auditor of State's office to get this warrant reissued.

Cash Reconciliation

- 1. We compared the sum of the cash balances recorded on the Executive Committee's Political Party Public Funds Report with the cash balances reconciled by the treasurer for the Highland County Democratic Executive Committee as of December 31, 2003. The sums agreed.
- 2. We recomputed the mathematical accuracy of the reconciliation. We found no computational errors.
- 3. We agreed bank balances on the reconciliation with month end bank statements. The balances agreed.

Cash Disbursements

1. Per review of the bank statements, there were no disbursements in 2003.

We were not engaged to, and did not perform an examination, the objective of which would be the expression of an opinion on compliance of the Political Party Public Funds Report which is attached to this report. Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion. Had we performed additional procedures, other matters might have come to our attention that we would have reported to you.
