INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT

To the Board of Trustees of Miami University Foundation and Ms. Mary Taylor Auditor of the State of Ohio:

We have audited the accompanying statements of financial position of Miami University Foundation (the "Foundation") as of June 30, 2007, and the related statements of activities and cash flows for the year then ended. These financial statements are the responsibility of the Foundation's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. The prior year comparative information has been derived from the Foundation's 2006 audited financial statements, upon which we expressed an unqualified opinion dated October 3, 2006.

We conducted our audits in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and the standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards*, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States of America. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. An audit includes consideration of internal control over financial reporting as a basis for designing procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Foundation's internal control over financial reporting. Accordingly, we express no such opinion. An audit also includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements, assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation. We believe that our audits provide a reasonable basis for our opinion.

In our opinion, such financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Foundation as of June 30, 2007, and the changes in its net assets and its cash flows for the years then ended, in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

Our audit was made for the purpose of forming an opinion on the basic financial statements taken as a whole. The schedule of changes in net assets by fund and the schedule of investments are presented for purposes of additional analysis and are not a required part of the basic financial statements. This information has been subjected to the auditing procedures applied in our audit of the basic financial statements and, in our opinion, is fairly stated in all material respects in relation to the basic financial statements taken as a whole.

The financial statements include investments that are not listed on national exchanges or for which quoted market prices are not available. These investments include limited partnerships, hedge funds, funds-of-funds, and commingled funds that are not mutual funds. Such investments totaled \$65,354,423 or 24 percent of net assets at June 30, 2007. Where a publicly-listed price is not available, management uses alternative sources of information including the funds' audited financial statements, unaudited interim reports, lists of underlying fund holdings, and similar evidence provided by the fund managers to determine fair values of the investments.

In accordance with *Government Auditing Standards*, we have issued a report dated October 16, 2007, on our consideration of the Foundation's internal control over financial reporting and our tests of its compliance with certain provisions of laws, regulations, contracts and grants and other matters. The purpose of that report is to describe the scope of our testing of internal control over financial reporting and not to provide an opinion on the internal control over financial reporting or on compliance. That report is an integral part of an audit performed in accordance with *Government Auditing Standards* and should be read in conjunction with this report in considering the results of our audit.

MIAMI UNIVERSITY FOUNDATION Notes to the Financial Statements June 30, 2007

(1) Organization

Miami University Foundation (the Foundation) was organized on June 4, 1948 for the purpose of receiving and investing alumni contributions, and is governed by a Board of Trustees (the Board). The income earned on the Foundation's investments is periodically transferred to Miami University to further its educational and research activities.

The Foundation Board is comprised of twenty-nine members. Twenty-one members are elected by the Board and eight members are appointed by Miami University. At least two-thirds of the elected trustees are required to be alumni or former students of Miami University.

(2) Accounting Policies

(a) Fund Valuation -- For the Pooled Funds, the market value of the investments is determined at the end of each quarter and the incremental market value increase or decrease is distributed to the individual fund accounts based on the number of shares the fund owns at the beginning of the quarter.

(b) Method of Accounting -- The financial statements of the Foundation are prepared on the accrual basis. Resources of the Foundation are classified for reporting purposes into net asset classes based on the existence or absence of donor-imposed restrictions and state law. Unrestricted net assets represent the portion of funds for which there is no donor-imposed restriction on how the funds may be spent. Temporarily restricted net assets represent funds which may be expended based upon instructions from the donor, primarily restricted for student financial aid, educational and research activities, and capital improvements for Miami University. Permanently restricted net assets, or endowment funds, represent amounts received from donors with the restriction that the principal is invested in perpetuity and that only earnings be available for expenditure.

(c) Cash and Cash Equivalents -- Cash and cash equivalents consists primarily of cash in banks, money market accounts, and the State Treasury Asset Reserve of Ohio (STAR Ohio) that include short-term, highly liquid investments readily convertible to cash, with an original maturity of three months or less. On June 30, approximately \$100,000 of cash and cash equivalents was covered by federal depository insurance and the remainder was not insured, exposing it to custodial credit risk. The Foundation maintains active relationships with multiple cash equivalent accounts to reduce its exposure to custodial credit risk at any single institution.

(d) Fair Value of Financial Instruments -- Statement of Financial Accounting Standards No. 107, *Disclosures About Fair Value of Financial Instruments*, defines the fair value of a financial instrument as the amount at which the instrument could be exchanged in a current transaction between parties. The carrying amounts of cash and cash equivalents, due from Miami University, other receivables, accounts payable and other, due to Miami University, approximate fair value due to the short maturities of these instruments. See Notes 3, 4 and 5 for disclosure regarding the fair value of investments, pledges receivable, deferred revenue, and obligations under split-interest agreements.

(e) Investment Valuation – Investments that are market traded, such as equity and debt securities, mutual funds, and cash equivalents, are recorded at fair value based on quoted market prices, as established by the major securities markets. The value of holdings of commingled funds investing in publicly traded stocks and bonds and not having a readily determined market value for fund units is based on the funds' net asset value as supplied by the investment manager. Investments in real estate are recorded at appraised value at the date of donation. The issuing insurance companies determine the cash surrender value of the paid-up life insurance policies annually. The Foundation's investment portfolio includes publicly traded securities. As a result, a significant downturn in the securities markets could adversely affect the market value of Foundation assets.

Market prices are not available for certain investments. These investments are carried at estimated fair value provided by the funds' managements. Some valuations are determined as of June 30, while the remaining valuations are determined as of March 31 and adjusted by cash receipts, cash disbursements, and securities distributions through June 30.

The Foundation believes that the carrying amounts are reasonable estimates of fair value as of year-end. Because these investments are not readily marketable, the estimated value is subject to uncertainty and, therefore, may differ from the value that would have been used had a ready market for the investments existed. Such differences could be material. The amount of gain or loss associated with these investments is reflected in the accompanying financial statements using the equity method of accounting.

Investment income is recorded on the accrual basis and purchases and sales of investments are recorded on a trade-date basis. Investment transactions occurring on or before June 30 which settle after such date are recorded as receivables or payables.

(f) Nature of Restricted Net Assets -- All temporarily and permanently restricted net assets have been restricted by independent donors for the financial support of Miami University. The Ohio Uniform Management of Institutional Funds Act (the Act) specifies that the governing board of an institution may appropriate for expenditure for the uses and purposes for which an endowment fund is established, up to 100% of the net realized and unrealized appreciation in the fair value of the assets of the endowment fund over the historic value of the fund.

In accordance with a prudent investment policy for capital preservation, the Foundation has reinvested 50% of excess net asset appreciation in the permanently restricted endowment funds. The remaining 50% is classified in temporarily restricted funds, as it may be available for current and future use as dictated by donor instruction.

(g) Income Taxes -- The Foundation is a not-for-profit organization as defined under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and, as such, is exempt from federal income taxes.

(h) Estimates -- In preparing the financial statements, management has made, where necessary, estimates and judgments based on currently available information that affect certain amounts reflected in the financial statements. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Fair values were determined based on prices of established securities markets, with the exception of some hedge funds and alternative investments whose fair values were provided by the funds' managements. Alternative investments generally represent investments that are less liquid than publicly-traded securities and include private equity, investments in real assets and other strategies. Hedge funds may include, but are not limited to, long and short investments in domestic and international equity securities, distressed securities, fixed

income securities, currencies, commodities, options, futures, and other derivatives. Many of these securities are intended to reduce market risk, credit risk, and interest rate risk. As of June 30, 2007, the Foundation has made commitments to limited partnerships totaling \$29.8 million that have not yet been funded.

The 2007 dividend and interest income of \$2,486,688 is reported net of fees from external investment managers totaling \$672,653.

(4) Pledges Receivable

As of June 30, 2007, contributors to the Foundation have made unconditional pledges totaling \$55,593,957 with 8 pledges accounting for over 50% of that total. Net pledges receivable have been discounted to a net present value of \$49,692,193 which represents fair market value. Discount rates ranged from 4.52% to 4.92% for 2007. Management has set up an allowance for uncollectible pledges of \$1,893,489. All pledges have been classified as temporarily restricted net assets since they will either expire or be fulfilled within a specified time. These pledges are due as follows:

At June 30, 2007, the Foundation had also been notified of revocable pledges, bequests, and other indications of intentions to give. These potential contributions have not been substantiated by unconditional written promises to the Foundation. The Foundation's policy is not to record these intentions to give as revenues until they are reduced to writing or are collected.

(5) Split-Interest Agreements

Split-interest agreements are contributions in the form of irrevocable charitable remainder annuity trusts and unitrusts, pooled life income funds, and charitable gift annuities which have been received from donors subject to obligations to pay stipulated amounts periodically to the donors or designated beneficiaries during their lifetimes. Assets held in trust for which the Foundation serves as trustee are included in investments, and the present value of the estimated future payments to be made to the donors and/or other beneficiaries is included in liabilities. The liabilities are adjusted during the term of the trusts for changes in the value of the assets, amortization of the discount, and other changes in the estimates of future benefits. Assets held in trust for which the Foundation does not serve as trustee are not included in investments; however, the contribution revenue and a pledge receivable for the estimated present value of the expected future cash flows to be received are recorded by the Foundation.

(6) Miami University Paper Science & Engineering Foundation

The Miami University Paper Science & Engineering Foundation, an independent corporation, has invested \$2,425,000 in the Foundation's Pooled Fund. This investment may be withdrawn at the discretion of the Miami University Paper Science & Engineering Foundation Board of Trustees. At June 30, 2007, the status of this investment was:

(8) Distributions to Miami University

Annually the Foundation establishes a spending rate which defines the total amount of dividends, interest and realized gains to be distributed from the investment pools. The total authorized spending amount in 2007 was \$9,092,140. Of this amount, a portion was returned to permanently restricted principal in accordance with donors' stipulations, a portion was held for distribution to the Miami University Paper Science & Engineering Foundation, and \$7,746,872 was distributed to Miami University. Permanently restricted accounts with insufficient accumulated earnings did not make a current year distribution. In addition to current year earnings distributions, \$7,463,417 was distributed from accumulated earnings in accordance with donors' stipulations. ### INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT ON INTERNAL CONTROL OVER FINANCIAL REPORTING AND ON COMPLIANCE AND OTHER MATTERS BASED ON AN AUDIT OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS PERFORMED IN ACCORDANCE WITH GOVERNMENT AUDITING STANDARDS

To the Board of Trustees of Miami University Foundation and Ms. Mary Taylor, Auditor of the State of Ohio:

We have audited the financial statements of the Miami University Foundation (the "Foundation") as of and for the year ended June 30, 2007, and have issued our report thereon dated October 16, 2007 which includes an explanatory paragraph regarding the valuation of investments. We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and the standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards*, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States.

### Internal Control Over Financial Reporting

In planning and performing our audit, we considered the Foundation's internal control over financial reporting as a basis for designing our auditing procedures for the purpose of expressing our opinion on the financial statements, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Foundation's internal control over financial reporting. Accordingly, we do not express an opinion on the effectiveness of the Foundation's internal control over financial control over financial reporting.

A control deficiency exists when the design or operation of a control does not allow management or employees, in the normal course of performing their assigned functions, to prevent or detect misstatements on a timely basis. A significant deficiency is a control deficiency, or combination of control deficiencies, that adversely affects the entity's ability to initiate, authorize, record, process, or report financial data reliably in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles such that there is more than a remote likelihood that a misstatement of the entity's financial statements that is more than inconsequential will not be prevented or detected by the entity's internal control.

A material weakness is a significant deficiency, or combination of significant deficiencies, that results in more than a remote likelihood that a material misstatement of the financial statements will not be prevented or detected by the entity's internal control.

Our consideration of internal control over financial reporting was for the limited purpose described in the first paragraph of this section and would not necessarily identify all deficiencies in internal control that might be significant deficiencies or material weaknesses. We did not identify any deficiencies in internal control over financial reporting that we consider to be material weaknesses, as defined above.

### **Compliance and Other Matters**

As part of obtaining reasonable assurance about whether the Foundation's financial statements are free of material misstatement, we performed tests of its compliance with certain provisions of laws, regulations, contracts and grant agreements, noncompliance with which could have a direct and material effect on the determination of financial statement amounts. However, providing an opinion on compliance with those provisions was not an objective of our audit and, accordingly, we do not express such an opinion. The results of our tests disclosed no instances of noncompliance or other matters that are required to be reported under *Government Auditing Standards*.

We noted certain matters that we reported to management of the Foundation in a separate letter dated October 16, 2007.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Board of Trustees and management of the Foundation, and the Auditor of the State of Ohio and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties.
