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INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS' REPORT ON APPLYING AGREED-UPON PROCEDURES

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, to which the Democratic Executive Committee, Union County, Ohio (the Committee) agreed, solely to assist the Committee in evaluating its compliance with certain requirements included in Ohio Rev. Code Sections 3517.1012, 3517.13(X)(1), 2(b), (3)(a), and (4), 3517.17, and 3517.18, for the year ended December 31, 2010. The Committee is responsible for complying with these requirements. We followed the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants' attestation standards for agreed-upon procedures engagements and applicable attestation engagement standards included in the Comptroller General of the United States' *Government Auditing Standards*. The sufficiency of the procedures is solely the responsibility of the Committee. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

Cash Receipts

- 1. We inquired of the Committee whether they deposited all gifts from corporations, labor organizations and all gifts restricted to operations into the same fund into which they deposit amounts received from the State Tax Commissioner. Management informed us they received no such gifts.
- We inquired of the Committee whether they were required to complete a Statement of Political Party Restricted Fund Deposits Ohio Rev. Code Section 3517.17 requires (Deposit Form 30-A), for 2010. Management informed us there was no Political Party Restricted Fund Deposits due to close out of restricted account in 2009.
- 3. We inquired of the Committee whether they reopened a restricted fund bank account in 2010. Management informed us they closed the bank account in April 2009 and have not subsequently reopened a bank account for restricted funds as they have not received any restricted funds. We therefore inspected the last bank statement available, April 2009, and it showed a balance of \$0 (zero).

Cash Disbursements

 We inquired of the Committee whether they were required to complete a Statement of Political Party Restricted Fund Disbursements Ohio Rev. Code Section 3517.17 requires (Disbursement Form 31-B), for 2010. Management informed us there was no Statement of Political Party Restricted Fund Disbursements due to close out of restricted account in 2009.

We were not engaged to, and did not examine each *Statement of Political Party Restricted Fund Deposits* and *Statement of Political Party Restricted Fund Disbursements* filed for 2010, the objective of which would have been to opine on compliance. Accordingly, we do not express an opinion. Had we performed additional procedures, other matters might have come to our attention that we would have reported to you.
