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



DECEMBER 1

Sheriffs Monthly Allowance

Sheriff files with County Commissioners an itemized account of all actual and necessary transportation expenses for previous month (ORC 325.07).

DECEMBER 5

Prisoner Expenses

Sheriff provides County Commissioners with itemized account of actual cost of keeping and feeding prisoners during preceding month (ORC 311.20).

DECEMBER 19

Sexual Offender Registration Fees

Sheriff transmits to County Treasurer all sexual offender registration fees collected during the previous month.

DECEMBER 31

Annual Unpaid Fines

Annual report of fines and costs unpaid for more than one year before the date filed with County Commissioners (ORC 325.31(C))

Arson Offender Registration Fees

Sheriff sends to Attorney General any arson offender registration fees collected during preceding 3-month period.

Sheriff Record of Office

Sheriff provides County Auditor with a detailed record of all money paid into county treasury for previous month (ORC 2335.38).

Unpaid Sexual Offender Registration Fees

Sheriff reports to Attorney General all fees that have been due and unpaid for more than one year.
