

UAN is a user-friendly accounting software system created by the Auditor of State's office to support accounting and financial management activities of local governments in Ohio.

Two main components of UAN software are:

- **Accounting**

The system allows users to process all accounting transactions such as warrants, receipts, purchase orders, blanket certificates and bank reconciliations. Users are able to compile financial reports and perform other activities.

- **Payroll**

The UAN system provides users with the ability to process payroll checks, track employee earnings and withholdings and submit Electronic Funds Transfers (EFTs). A wide variety of reports can easily be created for both internal and external reporting purposes.

UAN Package

- By subscribing to UAN, users receive the accounting software as well as the latest computer equipment to run the program.

Installation

- UAN staff provides initial training and detailed instructions for installation.

Training

- Instruction is available at the UAN training center in Columbus.

Assistance

- Technical support is available to software users six days a week via telephone and e-mail.
